
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FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

2019 was a challenging year with political turmoil around Brexit and trade wars which had its impact on the economy and the volumes we transported. In the first quarter of 2019 we saw a positive influence of the expected Brexit, where companies secured their supply chain by ordering in advance and substantially increasing safety stock on the European continent as well as in the UK. As the year progressed, we saw turnover step by step softening on the back of trade wars and growing uncertainty around Brexit. Especially the last quarter of 2019 we saw a softening of volumes, leading to a year-end turnover of €496 million 2,1% below 2018.

AGG MILLION TURNOVER




Investments in 2019 were at €24,8 million of which €20,5 million in our fleet, the vast part being purchases of new tank containers. The other part included office buildings and workshop equipment to support our growth. Significant

Strategic partnership Den Hartogh Logistics and MOL Chemical Tankers Pte. Ltd.

The year started in February with the announcement of the strategic partnership of Den Hartogh Logistics and MOL Chemical Tankers Pte. Ltd. (MOLCT) in Singapore to jointly develop and streamline liquid chemical logistics services utilising tank containers, parcel chemical tankers and tank terminals. MOLCT is one of the global leaders in ocean transport, specialising in chemical parcel tankers for bulk liquid chemicals, vegetable oils and animal fats. As strategic partners we offer our customers endto-end supply chain solutions on a truly global scale, by combining the tanker fleet and depots of MOLCT with the tank container fleet of Den Hartogh. These end-to-end supply chain solutions offer customers the best of both worlds, longtime expertise with the highest level of safety, efficiency and cost effectiveness on a global scale. During 2019 we have worked intensively together on bringing this concept to the market.

Logistics Service Center and Cluster Service in Antwerp

The introduction of our Cluster Services concept a couple of years ago has been well received by the market and is flourishing in the Rotterdam area where many logistic service providers work together with us to minimise empty truck mileage and reduce CO₂ emissions. Our Logistics Service Centers contribute to safe and efficient deliveries at our customers sites. To extend the services to our customers Den Hartogh decided to open the first Logistics Service Center in the Antwerp area, together with the Antwerp Cluster Service in the second half of 2019. Next to that, we started a dry bulk terminal project in Antwerp to link our European storage and distribution to products arriving from Asia, North America and the Middle East. In 2020 we will continue developing these and similar services to support our customers with their supply chain challenges.

TRUST AND Collaboration to build efficient Supply chains

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Supply chain visibility remains an important topic on our agenda. Accurate and real-time data increases visibility enabling a better control over logistics planning and processes and pro-active sharing of relevant information with customers. Data is available at multiple locations. The key lies in gathering all this data and make it available at one place. Therefore, we have set up several ICT projects to increase real-time data into Den Hartogh's systems. This is own data from our trucks, data from trucking sub-contractors, from rail and shortsea partners and even data from customers. We made strong progress on our journey towards supply chain visibility.

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
Launch of online visibility portal

In October Den Hartogh launched a first version of our online visibility portal for our Liquid Europe business. The portal provides early alerting for first and last mile transport and includes the intermodal connections. In parallel we have worked on an upgrade of our transport management system that contains an integral part of the data being loaded into the portal and is crucial for maximized visibility.

Also relating to an increased supply chain visibility, we have worked closely together with several customers, developing IT tools that create significant improvements in the supply chain visibility in logistics processes on site.

ECTA workgroup initiative

Den Hartogh was one of the parties that took the initiative to start up an ECTA workgroup on supply chain visibility creating standards for milestones on transport visibility as a contribution to complete supply chain visibility. The ECTA workgroup aims to develop an ECTA Transport Data and Message Definition Framework to improve "end to end" Supply Chain Visibility and Collaboration across the Chemical Logistics Bulk Liquid actors. Den Hartogh strongly believes in standardisation to further optimise the supply chain and is keen to work together with other actors in the Chemical Liquid Bulk supply chain to make this initiative a success.

Cooperation agreement in Shell's CO₂ compensation programme

In September Shell and Den Hartogh Logistics signed a cooperation agreement to offset the CO₂ emissions of the Den Hartogh fleet through participation in Shell's CO₂ compensation programme. Den Hartogh's contribution will be allocated to internationally certified CO₂ compensation projects in Peru, Indonesia and Kenya, which are not only aimed at tackling environmental effects, but to support local communities as well.

Den Hartogh Community Cares

Making a difference to those who need it, is close to Den Hartogh's heart. Den Hartogh Community Cares (DHCC) supports employees in realising socially responsible and charitable initiatives and to give back to the communities around Den Hartogh locations worldwide. In 2019 the company allocated around a tonne in Euros for social projects and 23 community events were organised by passionate Den Hartogh volunteers all over the world.



Award 'Best Employer of the Year 2018/2019 in Transport & Logistics'




