



UPDATE ON IMPLEMENTATION

In January 2023 Den Hartogh Dry Bulk set new KPI's and targets toward the goal of Zero Pellet Loss.

Below is a summary of performances at 31 December 2023:

- Trucking Partners that have signed the OCS Pledge: 30%
 - 2023 target: 30%2024 target: 70%2025 target: 100%



- Total estimated amount of plastic spillages: 116.25kg x 1,000 jobs
- Total estimated amount of plastic loss, due to spillages: 5.83kg x 1,000 jobs
 - The 2024 target for this KPI has been set at <100kg of product spilled x 1,000 jobs. The improvement plan agreed, focusing on the discharge equipment.
- The amendment to REACH regulations of 25/09/2023 requires registered companies (our chemical Customers) to report plastic losses into the environment to relevant authorities.
- Our Customer now require Den Hartogh to provide more accurate reporting of plastic losses. Written instruction EMS012 for reporting of spillages has already been circulated. If you would like more information, please contact pcanta@denhartogh.com
- All spillages of more than 0.5kg must be reported and logged into SwiftXP. The following information shall be included:
 - Estimate of the quantity spilled
 - Location
 - Description of the surface affected by the spillage
 - Whether the spillage entered into storm drains
 - If known: whether the storm drains were protected by a sieve or screen or other system to prevent the spillage to enter a watercourse.
